Active Learning Space Descriptions:

Learn2 Collaborative Seating - these seats have an attached adjustable tablet with wheels that permit rearranging in groups.

Media-Sharing - Monitor positioned at each table w/ switching equipment permitting instructor to send common information all locations or place individual table mode for control by students. Projections screens are also placed at each end of the room for content display by instructor.

SCALE-UP - Student Centered Active Learning Environment / Upside-down Pedagogy which has 6-person tables and multiple projection screens or monitors located strategically around the room so content can be viewed from various sightlines. Switching can be used to control content to various monitors.

Turn-To-Team - Two fixed counter tables per tier permitting the students at the front table to turn and join the table behind in group or team exercises.

(1) Seating increased to 77 in lecture configuration @ 16.96 sq. ft. / seat.

(2) Seating increased to 73 in lecture configuration @ 17.75 sq. ft./seat.
